LOCAL STATE OF EMERGENCY PROCLAMATION

A State of Emergency is hereby declared in Hastings-on-Hudson, NY for a period of time beginning at 12 pm on the date of March 17, 2020 and continuing in effect for a 30 day period and ending at 12 pm on the date of April 16, 2020.

The State of Emergency has been declared due to emergency conditions produced by:

the continued escalation of cases of COVID 19 in Westchester County, New York State and the United States. Both travel-related cases and community contact transmission of COVID-19 have been documented in New York State and are expected to continue. Accordingly, the Village Of Hastings-on-Hudson, New York is addressing the threat that COVID-19 poses to the health and welfare of its residents and visitors.

Such conditions threaten or imperil the public health and safety of the citizens of this municipality.

As Mayor and as Chief Executive of this municipality, we have exercised the authority given to us under New York State Executive Law, Article 2-B, to preserve the public safety and hereby render all required and available assistance vital to the security, well-being and health of the citizens of the community.
